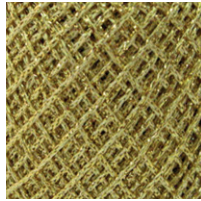
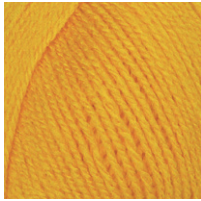

Gusset and Dowel Cover

WHAT YOU NEED

2.00mm and 3.00mm
crochet hooks.
Wooden Dowel approx
45cm, 18ins long and
1cm, 3/4ins in diameter.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch(s): chain(s)
st(s): stitch(es)
sc: single crochet
rept: repeat

BASE GUSSET

Using 3.00mm hook and Mustard ch 10.
1st row - 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each st along. 9 sts. Ch 1, turn. (Ch 1 counts as first st on next and every row after).
2nd row - 1 sc in each st along. Ch 1, turn. Rept 2nd row until the Gusset fits around base evenly.
Fasten off.

Dowel Cover (worked in a continuous spiral)
Using 2.00mm hook, ch enough sts to fit around the dowel thickness and ss tog to form a ring. Work 1 sc into each ch around. Work 1 sc in each st around until the fabric covers the whole length of the dowel. At regular intervals during crocheting it is advised to keep inserting the dowel and stretching the fabric to make sure it will fit once the piece has been crocheted. Fasten off leaving a long end.

MAKING UP
Insert dowel and using long end sew the tube closed. This will be hidden in the base so it has to be secured very well to the dowel.
